Dear Mr. Strasma:

The Department has received your letter dated March 8, 2018 regarding the corridor protection for the Prairie Parkway. We offer the following responses to your questions.

1. IDOT is using multiple ways to share this decision with the general public and to notify affected owners. The Notice for Abolition of Protected Corridor – Prairie Parkway was recorded in Grundy, Kendall, and Kane counties on March 5, 2018. IDOT is currently preparing letters to affected property owners notifying them that the corridor protection has been abolished. IDOT anticipates that these letters will be completed and mailed within a week. IDOT will publish the Notice for Abolition of Protected Corridor – Prairie Parkway in a local newspaper in Grundy, Kendall, and Kane counties. IDOT anticipates that the Notice will be published late in March or early in April.
2. Parcels acquired will be evaluated as potential excess land on a case by case basis. Those details are still being determined.
3. If excess land parcels are sold, the payment is made to the Treasurer of the State of Illinois and deposited in the Road Fund.
